On **Monday, October 26, 2020 at 6:30 p.m.** the Veneta City Council will hold a public hearing regarding proposed changes to Veneta Comprehensive Plan.

NATURE OF CHANGES

To amend the Veneta Comprehensive Plan Parks Element, and adopt the **2020 Veneta Parks, Recreation and Open Space Master Plan.** File #A-2-20

APPLICABLE CRITERIA

All proposed changes must comply with applicable Statewide Planning Goals, Veneta Comprehensive Plan policies, and Veneta Land Development Ordinance 493.

Citizens may present testimony for or against the requested changes by submitting written comments or by giving oral testimony at the public hearing on **Tuesday, October 26, 2020.** Written comments may be submitted at Veneta City Hall; 88184 8th Street, Veneta, Oregon; mailed to City of Veneta, P. O. Box 458, Veneta, OR 97487; sent by FAX (541) 935-1838; or sent by e-mail to emackenzie@ci.veneta.or.us by **October 22, 2020.** Information regarding the proposal is available at Veneta City Hall, 88184 8th Street, Veneta, Oregon. **Written comment deadline extended to Friday, November 6.**

The City Council will review the request for compliance with applicable criteria based upon information in the staff report, the recommendation of the Planning Commission and public comment submitted. A staff report will be available for review at Veneta City Hall 7 days prior to the public hearing. Copies of the applicable ordinance, the application, the staff report, and related documents can be purchased for the cost of copying. All public hearings will follow city land use hearing rules of procedure.

Failure to raise an issue accompanied by statements or evidence sufficient to afford the Council and the parties an opportunity to respond to the issue precludes appeal to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) based on that issue. The failure of the applicant to raise constitutional or other issues relating to the decision or conditions of approval with sufficient specificity to allow LUBA to respond to the issue precludes an action for damages in circuit court.
